The National Citizen Service (NCS) wearencs.com and onemillionmentors.org.uk, (1MM) have launched a unique mentoring scheme to support the career development of young people in Greater Manchester.

The scheme works by pairing up mentees with mentors from a diverse range of sectors and backgrounds, offering young people one-to-one mentoring so that they can gain the knowledge, networks, skills and confidence they need to succeed.

The 1MM/NCS project is supporting several Youth Partners across Greater Manchester including Sale Sharks Advantage Programme, Xaverian College and HideOut Youth Zone.
