Freelance Videographer / Editor:

We are looking to engage a Freelance Videographer / Editor to work alongside the Young Manchester Communications team to deliver the filmic elements of the 'LET'S RECAP IT!' project. They will create a film, using a mix of existing content and new content, which will document the Youth & Play fund webpage in an accessible, fun and dynamic way.

This role will be responsible for:

- Capturing footage (including interviews, b-roll etc)
- Working with the Project Lead and the Freelance Graphic Designer / Animator to co-ordinate aesthetic, narrative and editorial tone of the content
- Allowing Young Manchester 3 opportunities to request edits or amendments (up until final delivery)
- Ensuring any video content is delivered efficiently and to a high standard of quality

This role will deliver:

- 1 x Full length video (approx 10 minutes)
- 5 x Small Clips (extracted from the full length video)
- Any accessibility requests (e.g. subtitling, audio description etc)

- Have experience shooting / editing similar style videos
- Have access to suitable camera and sound equipment
- Have good communication & be willing to work collaboratively
- Be self-employed (or submitting their own tax return)

Freelance Graphic Designer / Animator:

We are looking to engage a Freelance Graphic Designer / Animator to work alongside the Young Manchester Communications team to deliver the graphic and animated elements of the 'LET'S RECAP IT!' project. You will create an accessible, fun and dynamic visual identity for the 'LET'S RECAP IT!' webpage – including the creation of graphic illustrations, infographics and short animations.

This role will be responsible for:

- Working with the Project Lead to develop a visual identity for the project which aligns with the Young Manchester brand guidelines
- Creating digital assets and animations to use on the webpage and in the supporting video
- Allowing Young Manchester 3 opportunities to request edits or amendments (up until final delivery)
- Ensuring any assets or content are delivered efficiently and to a high standard of quality

This role will deliver:

- A variety of digital assets as requested by the Project Lead (inc. graphics, infographics, illustrations etc)
- A variety of digital animations as requested by the Project Lead
